

## **Jury Duty Scam**

You get a phone call from someone identifying themselves as an officer of the court, representative of the court, some other official agency or a collection agency.

The caller states you failed to report for jury duty and a warrant is out for your arrest.

They then say it can be cleared up right now, but more information will be needed for “verification purposes”— such as your birth date, Social Security number, **OR** a credit card number to pay a “small fine”.

### **Hang up the phone. This is a SCAM!**

As a rule, the Jury Division will **never** ask for confidential information over the phone; we generally correspond with prospective juror’s official mail. When in doubt, call the District, Magistrate, or Federal court in your county.
