ORDER

Plaintiff/Defendant having made a Motion to stay this action by reason of military service in the United States armed forces.

This Court, having read the pleadings, having heard any testimony, and otherwise advised,

HEREBY FINDS:

- [] That Plaintiff/Defendant is in the military service of the United States as defined in the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940, as amended.
- [] That Plaintiff's/Defendant's ability to prosecute/defend in this action is materially affected by military service.
- [] That Plaintiff's/Defendant's ability to pay any tax or assessment or to comply with any obligation or liability at issue in this action is materially affected by military service.
- [] That Plaintiff's/Defendant's ability to comply with any judgment or order heretofore entered in this action is materially affected by military service.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this action be placed in the military stay file and be stayed during the period of military service as defined in the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940, as amended, and for three months thereafter.
