

REQUEST FOR UNREDACTED DOCUMENT FROM MAGISTRATE COURT

You have requested a document from the Magistrate Court which contains protected personal identifier information, such as full date of birth and full social security number.

If you are requesting a criminal complaint or other document filed by the prosecution, pursuant to Rule 6-114C(1)(c) NMRA, the prosecution is required to file both a redacted (without the protected personal identifier information) and unredacted (with the information) version of any document requiring the inclusion of protected personal identifier information. The prosecution has not followed this rule and has only filed an unredacted version. Please contact the prosecuting agency to obtain a copy of the document or file a motion to unseal the court record as set out in the rule.

If your request is for another type of document, the Court, under Rules 2-112 and 6-114 NMRA, cannot disclose an unredacted document containing protected personal identifier information to the public except by court order or pursuant to section H of the rule, the motion to unseal court records procedure. In order to obtain this document you must file a motion to unseal the court record.
